What's the appeal?

- Cheaper than a conventional RV macerator
- Parts available just about anywhere
- Longer warranty?
- Can handle tougher transport missions

Objectives (for my own system)

- Needed to be able to pump about 250', uphill
- 225 gallon total waste capacity and pumping distance meant I didn't want a small hose
- Only expected use in one location, so didn't want to spend several hundred dollars

3" Female Thread Adapter




Disposal Outlet


